Thursday's tend to be the heaviest day for traffic, so allowing ample time to reach your destination may prove to be more critical. <u>Eucharistic All-Night Adoration</u> – Wednesday, May 9^{th} – 10:00 PM through 07:00 AM on the May 10^{th} , 2018

St. Patrick's Basilica 220 Kent Street Ottawa, ON, Canada

The All-night adoration of the Blessed Sacrament begins at 10:00 pm following the Benediction and the vigil will be held in the Scavi (basement). It ends with the procession of the Blessed Sacrament from the Scavi to the main worship area of St. Patrick's Basilica for the 7:00 am Mass on Thursday the 10th of May. Entry to the Scavi can be gained by the side doors of the basilica, either Gloucester or Nepean Streets.

There will be the presence of a 4^{th} Degree honour guard. Dress for this guard for 4^{th} degree S/K's will be tuxedo, social baldric, jewel of office (if you an officer of your assembly) and name tag. This order of dress is most appropriate as you will be seated.

PLEASE NOTE:

Third degree brother knights are welcome and encouraged to participate in the guard anytime during the hours of 10:00 pm (Wed.) to 7:00 am (Thurs.). Dress shoes, dress pants, shirt and tie (with jacket, preferably) is the recommended order of dress. Third Degree social baldrics will be made available. Jewel of office (if you are an officer of your council) and name tags should be worn.

A minimum of two guards should be present during each hour of the All-Night Adoration. Guard duty is set at one hour shifts, with a change in guard being made at the top of each hour. As one might appreciate, the quiet hours are where assistance is most needed. Guards may, when the need arises, use the assembly chambers to relax and have a non-alcoholic refreshment which will be made available. The assembly chambers will also be utilized to gather and dress for the All-Night Adoration.

1. Rally on Parliament Hill - 12:30 pm

2. March Procession Through Downtown Ottawa - 1:30 pm
