DISTRICT MEETING

50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CANADIAN FLAG

On February 15, 1965 our national flag was raised for the first time on Parliament Hill.

Canada was just two years away from centennial celebrations when the maple leaf flag was made official by Royal Proclamation. In 1996, February 15th was declared National Flag of Canada Day and has been observed every year since.

A number of Assemblies from the Second Ontario District conducted Honour Guards and a variety of other activities to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Canadian Flag on Sunday February 15, 2015.
