From The Pulpit



Time is an artificial measure established by humans to mark change. We mark the passing of time with birthdays and anniversaries; some we want to remember, others we would like to forget. For God, there is no time. Today's reading from Isaiah reminds us that God's thoughts are not our thoughts, and God's ways are not our ways. Human understanding is limited. In the psalm, we are told that God's love is "better than life." Pope Francis teaches us that "God never tires of loving us but we tire of loving God." God gives us the time we need to repent and return to a relationship with him, just as the gardener in today's gospel is given the time he needs to help the fig tree produce fruit. One more year in the mind of God is not the same as one more year in our limited way of thinking about time. Of course, we ought not to presume upon God's goodness, and Saint Paul does tell us that those who put Christ to the test "are struck down." Today, as we gather around the table of the Lord, we have one more time to turn to God, to refresh and renew ourselves so that we may produce good fruit and go forth to help others do the same. Lent

Lent starts every year on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday, the day before Easter Sunday.

What do people do?

Many churches in Canada hold special Ash Wednesday services for their congregations. It is a time when people who seek penitence for their wrongdoings are marked with the sign of the cross, from blessed ashes, on their forehead. This symbolic occasion reminds people of their mortality and sorrow for sins, as well as the will for change and the hope of forgiveness.

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lenten discipline for many Christian churches. It is traditionally a time of fasting nd prayer as part or preparations for Easter when they are ready to receive or reaffirm their baptism. For some Christians, Lent is a time to think about life and death, as well as reflect on life's choices and possible life directions.

Ash Wednesday serves as a wakeup call for some Christians. It is also a time of goodwill for many





people. There are also those who chose this time of the year to donate to charities or take part in charity events as a way to get close to God.
