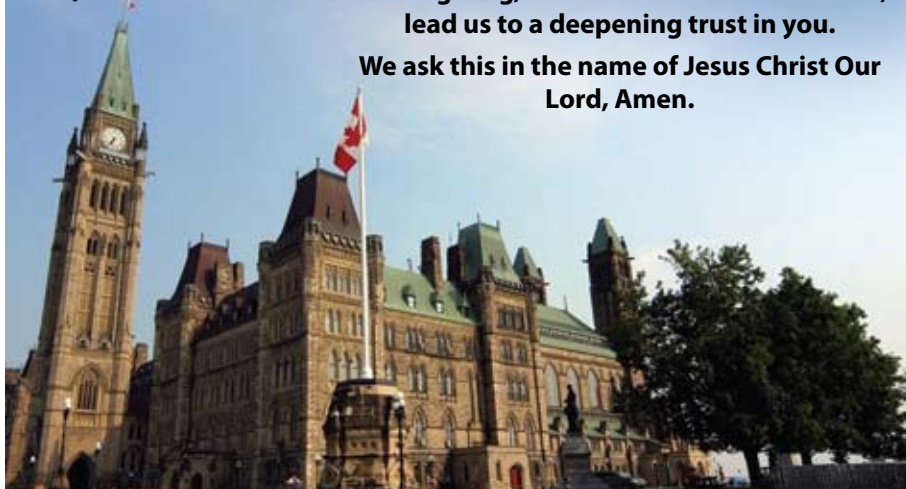

SK Rudy B. Montaniel, PGK, FDD, PFN

In 1988, SK Rudy B. Montaniel joined Maharlika Council 7488 and in 1989, Bishop Charles P. Greco assembly 2113. He had held a number of vital positions on the council and assembly executive officers, including Grand Knight in the former and Faithful Navigator in the latter. He is a Former District Deputy of District 95 and had been recycled thrice as a Grand Knight.



Currently, SK Rudy is a member of the district staff as a District Marshal and a member (Expositor) of the 4th degree Exemplification team of the Second Ontario District, both of which he has held since September, 2014. He is also a member of the 1st (since 1988) and 2nd (since 1995) degree exemplification teams.

Upon joining the 4th Degree, SK Rudy served in most executive officer positions and is a Past Faithful Navigator in Bishop Charles P. Greco Assembly 2113. As Navigator, he started the assembly's Newsletter and revised its by-laws. Realizing that most of the member SKs come from Scarborough, together with the late Rev. Fr, Joseph Fenech and the late SK Victor Cardoso, he orchestrated the move of the assembly location from North York Council chamber to St. Aidan Parish in Scarborough. For several years, he was a key committee member for the Patriarchate of Jerusalem fundraising events;

Right after his tenure as a Navigator, he took the helm of Faithful Corps Commander which he is still holding since 2001. A lot of changes in the assembly's H/G services ensued. A Commander was assigned to his respective parish and council within the assembly's jurisdiction, making him their spokesperson. A drill manual, a H/G schedule and outing report had been created. In fact, a facsimile of the latter is now used by the district. Since 2001, the assembly has been conducting over a hundred H/G services, not including the number of invitational H/G services from other assemblies and the district. He took charge of the assembly's communication in as far as the social and H/G services are concerned.

In recognition of his effort and accomplishment, the late Faithful Master, SK Paul Gouin, awarded SK Rudy, the "Best Commander" award in the 2nd Ontario District in Oct. 2003. Incidentally, Bishop Charles P. Greco Assembly received the "No. 1 assembly" award.

As a District Deputy, SK Rudy received the "Star District" award in 1997.

In 2017, SK Rudy is also a recipient of the "Outstanding Canadian Award", in conjunction with the Canada-150 celebration for his religious and community involvement.

All of us on the Second Ontario District are truly proud of SK Rudy as one of this year's well-deserved Honourees of the June 2018 Fourth Degree Exemplification.

History of the Fourth Degree

This history of the creation of the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus is directly linked to the social and political climate in the United States at the turn of the last century. It is in that light that the connection between the Fourth Degree and its Color Corps, that has grown to be the most visible aspect of the Knights, must be seen.

The idea of adding new degrees to the Order's original three, (Charity, Unity, Fraternity) first came to light in 1886. Supreme Knight James T. Muller appointed a committee to look into Forming two new commander degrees. That same year the Connecticut Catholic, a local newspaper, carried an advertisement calling members of local Knights of Columbus councils to meet to form a Uniformed Legion. The idea for this new unit arose from a growing nation wide sense of Nationalism, or what we would call today Patriotism. The unknown author in Connecticut was not alone in wanting a visible organization.

Little happened at this time because there was not enough wide spread interest in creating additional new degrees. The Order's leaders balked at the idea of a Uniformed Legion for the simple reason that the cost for the Uniform was well over \$100.00. They feared the Legion would cause an economical class split between wealthy and poorer members of the Order.

Following the Spanish American War, it was decided that there should be one new Degree added based on the principle of Patriotism. In 1899, Edward L. Hearn was elected Supreme Knight and he immediately appointed a committee to establish and format the new Degree to be given the following year.

In order to qualify for this Degree each candidate had to be a Third Degree member of the Knights of Columbus in good standing for three years, and show evidence of distinctive service to the Order, church, and community.

Finally the candidate had to have a letter from his priest stipulating that he had received communion within the past two weeks.

The Patriotic Degree formally became a part of the Order in a ceremony on George Washington's Birthday in 1900.



History of the Fourth Degree



The first Exemplification of the new Degree was scheduled to be held in the Astor Hotel in New York City on February 22, 1900. However, there were so many candidates; the Exemplification had to be moved to a larger venue.

Therefore the site was moved to the Lenox Lyceum. At this first Exemplification of the Fourth Degree 1,100 members of the Knights of Columbus, being in good standing took their fourth. The second Exemplification, held in Boston on May 8, 1900 saw another 750 Third Degree knights join the ranks of Sir Knights.

In the early years of the Fourth Degree, members met as part of their councils, mostly after meetings. In 1910, during a reorganization of the Order's leadership, the first Assemblies were created. Additionally the position of Supreme Master was established to lead the Fourth Degree internationally. Vice Supreme Masters lead Provinces and Masters head Districts.

The system has spread and flourished as Sir Knights not only serve their local Church through their service to local councils but also their joint efforts in these Assemblies.

The Honor Guard, first called for in 1886 was officially formed in 1902, for ceremonial purposes. Since that time, the uniforms of the Color Corps have varied, however all have shared the similar theme of mariners. Most noticeable in today's current uniform is the chapeau worn with ostrich feathers.

In the year 2000, the Fourth degree celebrated its 100th anniversary with approximately 252,000 member Sir Knights.

Last year, 17,689 Knights advanced to the Fourth Degree, bringing the total of Sir Knights to 358,907. During this time, 81 new assemblies were established making their total 3,412.

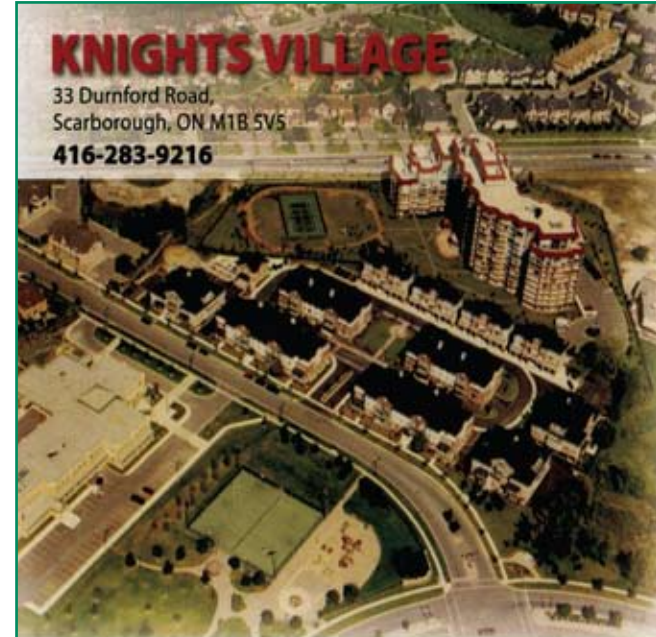

Fr. James J. Farrell S.J. Scarborough Council 3296 opened Knight's Village in 1992.

The 'Village' is a \$24 million dollar complex of 12 buildings that sits on a four acre site in a quiet residential area of Scarborough. There are 164 apartments comprised of 1, 2 and 3 bedroom units. The apartments are home to approximately 550 seniors, single, young adults and families. As we welcome both market and subsidized tenants, we continue to be one of the most sought-after non-profit homes in Toronto.

The 'Village' is managed by a Board of Directors, composed exclusively of Brother Knights from Council 3296. With the direction and assistance of the City of Toronto Shelter, Support & Housing Administration, we serve the housing needs of the low income as well as welcoming the newly arrived immigrants to Canada in the true spirit of Columbianism. Several members of the Knights of Columbus and their families are pleased to call us home.


